Valley of Flowers Trek - Best For Monsoon Holiday

A Magical Land of Flowers and Legends

The Valley of flowers Uttarakhand is a world heritage site in the far interiors of the Garhwal Himalayas, which is spread over 87.5 sq. km. It is also part of the famous Nanda Devi Biosphere. It is at an altitude of 3250 metres above sea level and is home to many endemic varieties of alpine flowers and plants.

Many rare and endangered animal species live in this region, including the Asiatic black bear, brown bear, snow leopard, blue sheep, and others. Our trek into the valley will have you walking mostly to most parts of the area and, at times, climbing up to the beautiful vantage point to observe the immense beauty of this natural world.

To make this trek comfortable for a wider audience, we have a beautiful and very comfortable campsite at Ghangria as a base for explorations into the valley. Different flowers bloom in different months, but the peak blooming period is from mid-July to mid-August. Almost 300 species of wildflower thrive here unhindered by humanity.

The prominent species are Brahmakamal, Blue Poppy, Cobra Lily, Anemone, Geranium, and Marsh Marigold & Prinula. Also, the valley of flowers, Uttarakhand, has to offer much more than flowers. There are waterfalls, glaciers, towering mountains, big rivers, and



quaint villages. These myriad shades of the valley will ensure that you have a most memorable trip to the mountains.

Detailed Valley of Flowers Trek Itinerary

Day 1: Rishikesh to Joshimath/Pipalkoti (253 km, 8-hour drive)

The journey begins early in the morning as the group assembles at the pickup point in Rishikesh at 6:30 AM. We will drive along the scenic Badrinath road, witnessing the breathtaking confluence of four rivers—Devprayag, Rudraprayag, Karnaprayag, and Nand Prayag. The Alaknanda River flows beside us, making the long drive even more beautiful. Upon reaching Joshimath/Pipalkoti in the evening, we will check into our designated hotel, enjoy a delicious dinner, and rest for the night.

Note: The pickup point is Natraj Chowk / Tapovan Chowk (tentative).

**Day 2: Joshimath/Pipalkoti to Pulna (22 km, 1-hour drive) | Trek to Ghangaria (9 km, 5-hour trek)**

After an early breakfast, we will have a briefing session where our trek leader will provide essential details about the Valley of Flowers trek. Then, we will drive to Pulna, the starting point of the trek. From Pulna, we will begin our trek toward Ghangaria village, which is situated at 9,800 ft. The trail follows the river for most of the journey, with several dhabas and shops along the way for refreshments. As the trail flattens, we will know we are close to Ghangaria. Upon arrival, we will check into our accommodation, have dinner, and rest for the night.

Day 3: Ghangaria to Valley of Flowers | Return to Ghangaria (10 km, 7-hour trek)

After breakfast, we will head towards the breathtaking Valley of Flowers National Park. The trek involves a gradual altitude gain from 9,600 ft to 11,500 ft, making it a comfortable walk. After reaching the forest check post, we will get our entry tickets and step into a mesmerizing landscape filled with over 300 species of blooming flowers. The valley stretches for nearly 6-7 km, ending at a glacier. Since camping and eating are not allowed inside the valley, we will soak in the stunning views before making our way back to Ghangaria for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 4: Ghangaria to Hemkund Sahib (14 km, 9-hour trek) | Return to Ghangaria

After breakfast, we will begin our steep ascent to Hemkund Sahib, the world's highest Gurudwara at 15,200 ft. The trek is challenging, with a stone-paved uphill path, but porters and mules are available to assist if needed. Along the way, small shops offer refreshments to keep us energized. Upon reaching Hemkund Sahib, we will visit the Gurudwara and the sacred Hemkund Sarovar, surrounded by the majestic Saptarishi peaks. After experiencing the spiritual serenity, enjoying hot chai, and relishing the famous Gurudwara khichdi, we will descend back to Ghangaria, where we will have dinner and rest for the night.

Day 5: Ghangaria to Pulna (9 km, 5-hour trek) | Drive to Joshimath/Pipalkoti (22 km, 1-hour drive)

After an early morning tea and breakfast, we will begin our descent to Pulna. The return trek is relatively easy, allowing us to enjoy the final views of the beautiful trails. Once we



reach Pulna, we will drive back to Joshimath/Pipalkoti. Upon arrival, we will check into our accommodation, enjoy a warm meal, and spend the night resting.

Day 6: Joshimath/Pipalkoti to Rishikesh (253 km, 8-hour drive)

On the final day of our journey, we will have morning tea and then begin our return drive to Rishikesh. The scenic journey will take us through the same mesmerizing landscapes, and we will arrive in Rishikesh by evening. The group will part ways with wonderful memories of the trek.

End of Tour.

1. When is the best time to visit the Valley of Flowers Uttarakhand?

The Valley is particularly attractive in May, June, and September. However, July and August are the best months to visit for the most blooms.

The Trek to Valley of Flowers is one of the most popular treks in India; and it is a very famous trek, and many people visit it yearly. This beautiful Valley spread over 1 km with various flowers growing all around is indeed a heaven on Earth. The best time to visit Valley of Flowers Uttarakhand during Mid-June to Mid-September.

Every day at 7:00 a.m, the Valley of Flowers National Park opens for visitors, and the last admittance is at 2:00 p.m. You should leave at 1:00 p.m. and return by 5:00 p.m.

On June 1st, the Valley of Flowers Uttarakhand expedition is available to the public every year. From June through October, the park is open to the public. You can register for the Package tour to Valley of Flowers by Paying Rs 3000 as advance payment.

The Valley has a wide range of wildflowers, mainly primulas and poppies.

4. What will happen if a trek is extended for any reason?

Beyond our controllable reasons, additional charges tend to be applied when the trek is extended. Valley of flowers trek best time is from July to August end. The national park is closed due to snowfall from October 2nd weekend.

5. What is the trekking distance from Ghangaria to the Valley of Flowers in Uttarakhand?

The Trek distance is four kilometres one way; the time required to cover this distance is six hours. You will gain Altitude from 9,600 feet to 11,500 feet. Flowers growing on both trail flanks make for a delightful expedition to the Valley of Flowers India.

28. Is Valley of Flowers open in April?

Valley of Flowers is snow clad for most of the year and is accessible only from June to September. ... Snow starts melting in April and the seeds put down by plants last year



start germinating. By June first week when Valley of Flowers is opened for public you see some small plants and very few flowers.

29. How far is Valley of Flowers from Auli?

Auli to Valley of flowers distance is 49 kms . Valley of flowers does not have a train station, and the nearest station is Kathgodam, at a distance of 206 kms from Valley of flowers.

35. Is the Valley of Flowers National Park Uttarakhand open in December?

Valley of Flower National Park, which remains covered under the snow, is open to the public on 1st June and closes on 4th October every as the winters set in and it is the time of fresh snowfall. Valley of Flowers is located in Chamoli district near Badrinath of Uttarakhand, approximately 300 km north of Rishikesh.

Flower valley trekking is inaccessible to the general touristy crowd because it's located at a great height, and to reach there, and you have to do a two-day trek.

- 1) By Air. The nearest airport is Jolly Grant at Dehradun. The airport is well connected by daily flights to Delhi.
- 2) By Train. Rishikesh is the nearest railway station. Taxis and buses are available from here to reach Govindghat.
- 3) By Road. Motorable roads exist only till Govindghat.

37. Can you tell me more about the Valley of Flowers Uttarakhand?

Valley of Flowers National Park was founded in 1982 as an Indian national park. It is located in Uttarakhand's Chamoli district and is famed for its indigenous alpine flower meadows and diverse vegetation. Rare and endangered creatures like the snow leopard, Asiatic black bear, brown bear, musk deer, red fox, and blue sheep live in this wonderfully diversified environment. Himalayan monal pheasant and other high-altitude birds can be seen in the park.

The alluring beauty of Valley of Flowers National Park, between 3352 and 3658 meters above sea level, contrasts with the rocky mountain wildness of Nanda Devi National Park to the east. Together, they form a unique transition zone between the Zaskar and Great Himalayan mountain ranges. The valley of Flower national park has an area of 87.50 km², approximately 8 km long and 2 km wide. The temperate alpine zone surrounds the park.



The Nanda Devi Biosphere Reserve, 223,674 acres, encompasses both parks and is further encircled by a buffer zone of 5,148.57 km². The UNESCO World Network of Biosphere Reserves includes Nanda Devi National Park Reserve.

Yumthang Valley, also known as the Sikkim Valley of Flowers refuge, is a nature sanctuary in North Sikkim, India, containing a river, hot springs, yaks, and grazing pasture on



undulating meadows surrounded by Himalayan mountains. It is 150 kilometers or 93 miles from the state capital Gangtok, at an elevation of 3,564 meters or 11,693 feet above mean sea level.

It is known as the Valley of Flower Sikkim and is home to the Shingba Rhododendron Sanctuary, which has over twenty-four kinds of the state flower, the Rhododendron. The blossoming season runs from late February to mid-June, when many flowers bloom, carpeting the Flower Valley in Sikkim with a kaleidoscope of colors. A branch of the Teesta flows through the Valley, passing into Lachung, the nearest populated center. Yumthang Flower valley Sikkim is closed between December and March due to severe snowfall. In the Valley, there is also a hot spring.

The Flower valley Sikkim's sole enduring habitation is a woodland rest hut. Rhododendrons, primulas, poppies, iris, and other flora grow throughout the area during spring. Villagers bring their cattle to these heights to graze during the summer months, a practice known as Yaylag Pastoralism. As the number of tourists grows, there is a risk of environmental degradation soon. In the Valley, skiing is done.
